Comprehensive Disaster Assessment and Readiness Tools (CDART)




CHALLENGE

During Hurricane Maria response activities, a need for standardized app-based data entry, with geospatial capabilities, and rapid dissemination of critical information was identified.



ACTION

The CDART team collaborated with the Puerto Rico Planning Board and Department of Health to develop a suite of preparedness and response app-based assessment tools and critical information dashboards.



OUTCOME

Increased capacity for the Puerto
Rico Department of Health to
prepare for and respond to
disasters and to rapidly
disseminate key information
for decision makers.
