Dollar amount of environmentally-focused grants/assistance awarded	The dollar amount of grants or other monetary assistance awarded to improve environmental conditions (e.g. a Brownfields Assessment grant)	Internal county/city/town or non-profit data
Number of organizations involved in redevelopment planning and community improvement	Number of organizations actively participating in redevelopment planning and community improvement, demonstrated through active behaviors that contribute to planning or improvement	Internal county/city/town or non-profit data
Number of partnership activities involved in redevelopment planning and community improvement	Number of partnership activities, such as information sessions, educational sessions, and volunteers engaged related to redevelopment planning and community revitalizations	Internal county/city/town or non-profit data
